

**TRAINING SESSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS
WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS TRUST FUND**

The European Court of Human Rights, with the support of the Human Rights Trust Fund, organises training sessions aimed at magistrates and lawyers within the framework of a Training institute located on the Court's premises. This programme is implemented in co-operation with the Council of Europe's HELP programme.

These intensive sessions allow participants to discover the Court from the inside, to attend a hearing, to meet with judges and registry members.

The travel and subsistence expenses of the participants are fully borne.

The first session will take place on 4 and 5 April 2012. This session is aimed at Armenian magistrates and lawyers. The session will be held in English; knowledge, even passive, of this language is preferable. The draft programme is appended.
